Official Rules

Tournament Time

- You may fish from 8:00 AM (CST) until 5:00 PM (CST)
- Nobody on the ice or holes drilled before 8:00AM (CST)-gather at the boat dock area
- Tournament will be limited to 40 teams
 - \$20 per team entry fee due before you begin fishing
 - Each **team** is limited to actively fishing 4 holes*
 - No help from friends or children (will result in team disqualification)
 - Permanent or portable shelters are allowed

Boundries

- North – Power lines crossing Missouri River at Casino Marina
- East – Hwy 1804 bridge
- South – Little Beaver Dr
- West – Missouri River west bank

Weigh-In

- **ALL** teams must sign in and register at Bayside, after fishing, **before 5:30 PM (CST)**
 - Late registration will result in team disqualification
 - At registration you will receive your ticket for door prize drawings
- You may take fish to Bayside throughout the day for weighing
 - Fish will be marked to prevent re-weighing
 - Fish can be held for you at weigh-in station
 - Once a fish is weighed you must keep it (no culling)
 - Maximum number of fish (walleye only) to weigh is 4
- Cash prizes paid for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place based on total weight of up to 4 fish

Note: There are no garbage cans at the dock. You pack it in, please pack it out. If you need something from Bayside such as bait or food, call 254-5540. They will deliver to the dock area and you can meet them there. However, they will not come get your fish for weigh-in.
